



## Biography

### Khusro Qasim

Professor Khusro Qasim is the author, researcher and professor at Aligarh Muslim University, born on March 1, 1963 in a family of the Sunni Hanafi religion in India. He has completed Bachelor, Master and Doctorate in Mechanical Engineering and is currently assistant professor of mechanical engineering. Professor Qasim is the corrector and author of 180 volumes of books in Urdu and Arabic which over a hundred volumes are about the virtues of the Ahl al-Bayt (AS). Among his works can be mentioned the book " Encyclopedia of Narrations of Amirulmominen (PBUH) and Ahle bayt (AS) in Books of Ahle sunnah", which includes thirteen volumes (5563 pages and 25713 hadiths). Furthermore, this book includes other sayings from Fatimah bt. al-Imam al-Husayn (as) and Lady Fatimah al-Zahra' (a) and also Zaid Ibn Ali. All these hadiths are gathered from the books of Sunni hadiths and their interpretation, jurisprudence and history. In this book, the Sayings of Imam Ali (as) is 15266. The book "Opening of the Secret Meanings of Manaqib e Ali Ibne Abitalib" was also published in two volumes, including 1,400 pages about the virtues of Imam Ali (as), in addition to other Sunnis from other Sunni books. He has published another work that includes the collection of the words of Imam Ali (as) in English. Professor Khusro Qasim has also presented over twenty papers on conferences in India, Singapore, Jordan, Denmark and Malaysia on Ahl al-Bayt (AS).
