About Researcher

Hamed Dehghani Firouzabadi was born in 1990 in Qom. He spent his high school years at Shahid Fahmideh High School in Qom. In 2008 he entered the Sharif University of Technology to study Electrical Engineering. After two years, he started to learn seminary courses too and took introductory courses at Masoumiyeh School of Islamic Seminary in Qom. He received a master's degree in Quranic and Hadith sciences from the Farabi Campus of the University of Tehran. His dissertation title was 'Source Oriented Approach to Shiite Hadith in Semantics of Quranic Terms'. He is currently writing his doctoral dissertation entitled 'Patterns of Signing social decrees in the Quran and Sunnah' in the same field and the same university. He seeks to reach a more or less accurate picture of the legal environment of the Quran by studying the legal cultures of the Near East, Iran, and ancient Rome, and to discover the logic of the Quran and Sunnah's confrontation with their former legal system. Dehghani has also collaborated with the Mersad seminary in several policy projects and is currently the scientific deputy of this collection.

Abstract

Ahl al-Bayt's lexical Hadiths and the linguistic usages in their speeches are very valuable in terms of arabic literature. With damages done to the lexical resources, it is necessary to count Ahl al-Bayt's Hadiths a source of Semantics of Quranic terms. The main issue in this thesis is identifying a source-oriented approach to Shiite's Hadiths in Semantics of Quran. The primary resources of Arabic vocabulary have damaged from diverse ways and they could not able to convey the language of the age of descent properly. These are a set of basics that we can defend from source-oriented approach to Ahl al-Bayt's Hadiths in Semantic of Quran: the Ahl al-Bayt's immunity of sin, the equality of Quran and Ahl al-Bayt, being scientific reference for muslims, the Islamic language revolution and their important role in explaining religious vocabulary, the quiddity of semantic hadiths, historical fame of the eloquence and rhetoric of Ahl al-Bayt, the alignment of Ahl al-Bayt's language with the language of Quran and the regularity transmission of Shiite's Hadith. The most important reasons of accepting the Hadith are the immunity of the lexical level of Hadith from some pests of Hadiths and clarity implication of Hadith. Imamieh scholars's attitudes to lexical passages into linguistic usage in Hadith were not as well as their attitudes of the use of the Hadith. The result of this research shows Ahl al-Bayt's Hadiths are more effective than other lexical sources.
